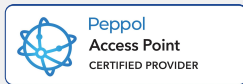
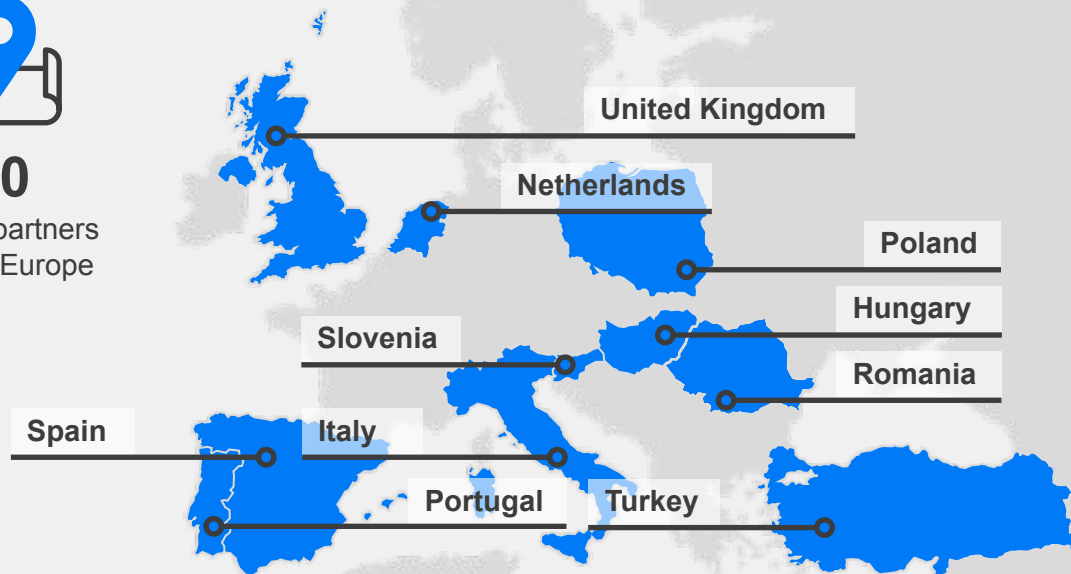

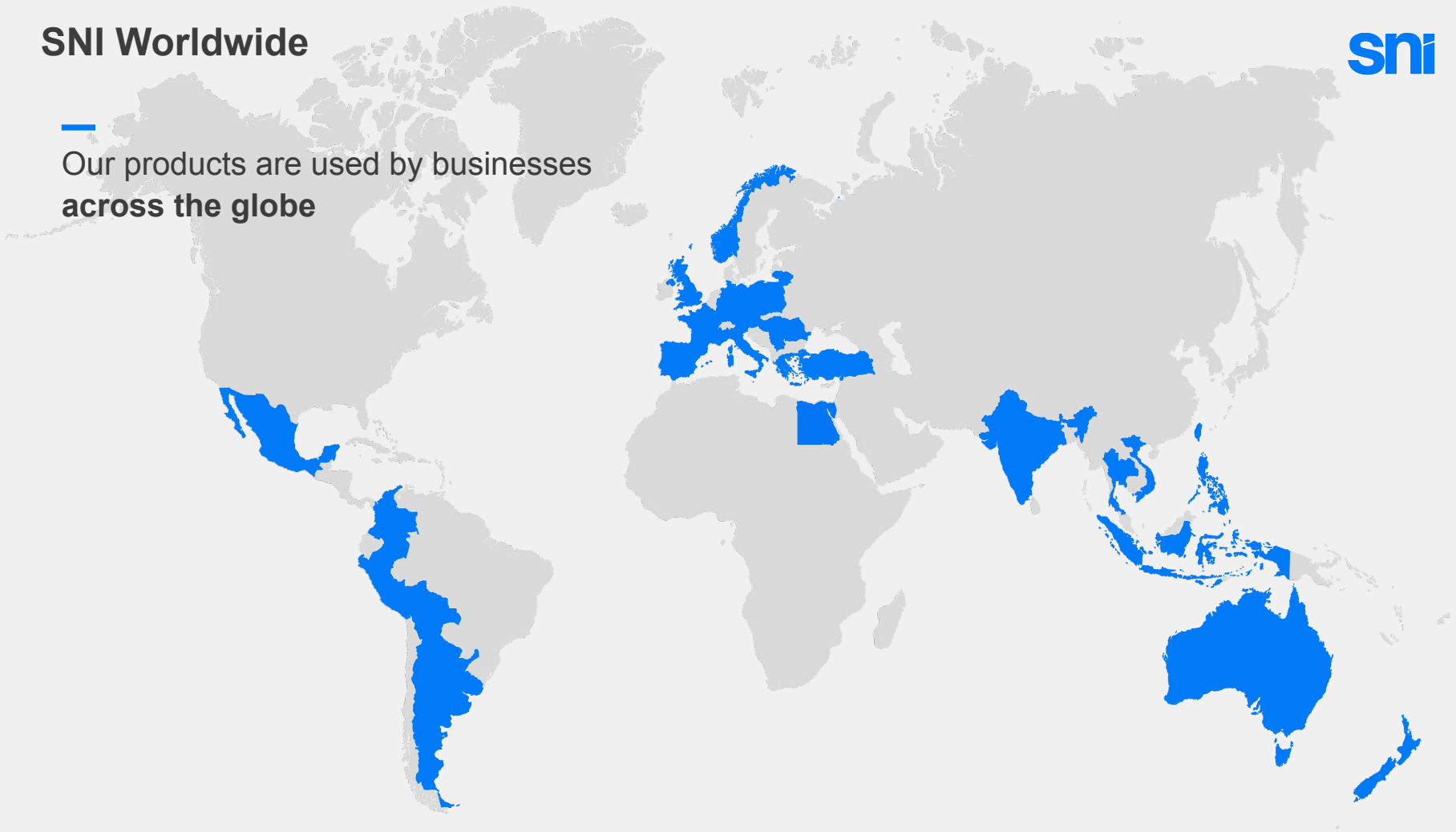

Public Procurement E-invoicing in Portugal - B2G



In Europe, B2G e-invoicing is currently mandatory in:

France	Norway
Italy	Lithuania
Spain	Latvia
Belgium	Switzerland
Netherlands	UK (at NHS)
Austria	Czechia
Croatia	Denmark
Finland	Estonia
Slovenia	Iceland

Next countries to adopt B2G E-invoicing:

Germany
Portugal

From 18 April 2020, all Portuguese public authorities must be able to receive invoices in electronic format, following the Directive 2014/55/ EU of the European Parliament.

Now, all government vendors must be ready to send invoices in electronic format to the authorities. The gradual implementation of mandatory B2G e-invoicing:

1 January 2021: Large companies (employs more than 250 people or has an annual turnover of more than 50 million euros or a total annual balance sheet of more than 43 million euros)

1 July 2021: Medium companies (employs less than 250 people and has an annual turnover of 50 million or less or a total annual balance of 43 million or less) and Small companies (employs less than 50 people and has an annual turnover or total annual balance of 10 million euros or less)

1 January 2022: Microenterprises (employs less than 10 people and has an annual turnover or annual balance sheet of 2 million euros or less) and Public Entities

Entities linked to the use of the FE-AP solution:

The State's Direct Administration Bodies such as Directorates-General, Regional Directorates, General Secretariats, DGEstE, ASAE, AT, IGF

Public institutes, for example, eSPap, IAPMEI, INEM, IPDJ, ISS, among others.

Voluntary entities:

The Presidency of the Republic;

The Assembly of the Republic;

The Attorney General's Office;

The courts;

Independent administrative entities, with regulatory functions;

Public business sector entities (hospitals);

The public higher education institutions (universities)

How does the new e-invoicing system work?

- 1) Registration by eSPaP
- 2) Testing
- 3) Go live

Suppliers must;

- issue all their invoices in XML format,
- digitally sign each invoice and
- send them to the FE-AP portal via web-service.

Qualified electronic signature on electronic invoices is mandatory. Suppliers must procure a certificate from accredited certification providers.

As of January 2021, all the invoices must include a QR and Unique ID code called ATCUD. To obtain the code, taxpayers have to previously notify the Portuguese Tax Authority the invoice series they will use. Then, taxpayers will receive a code for each invoice.

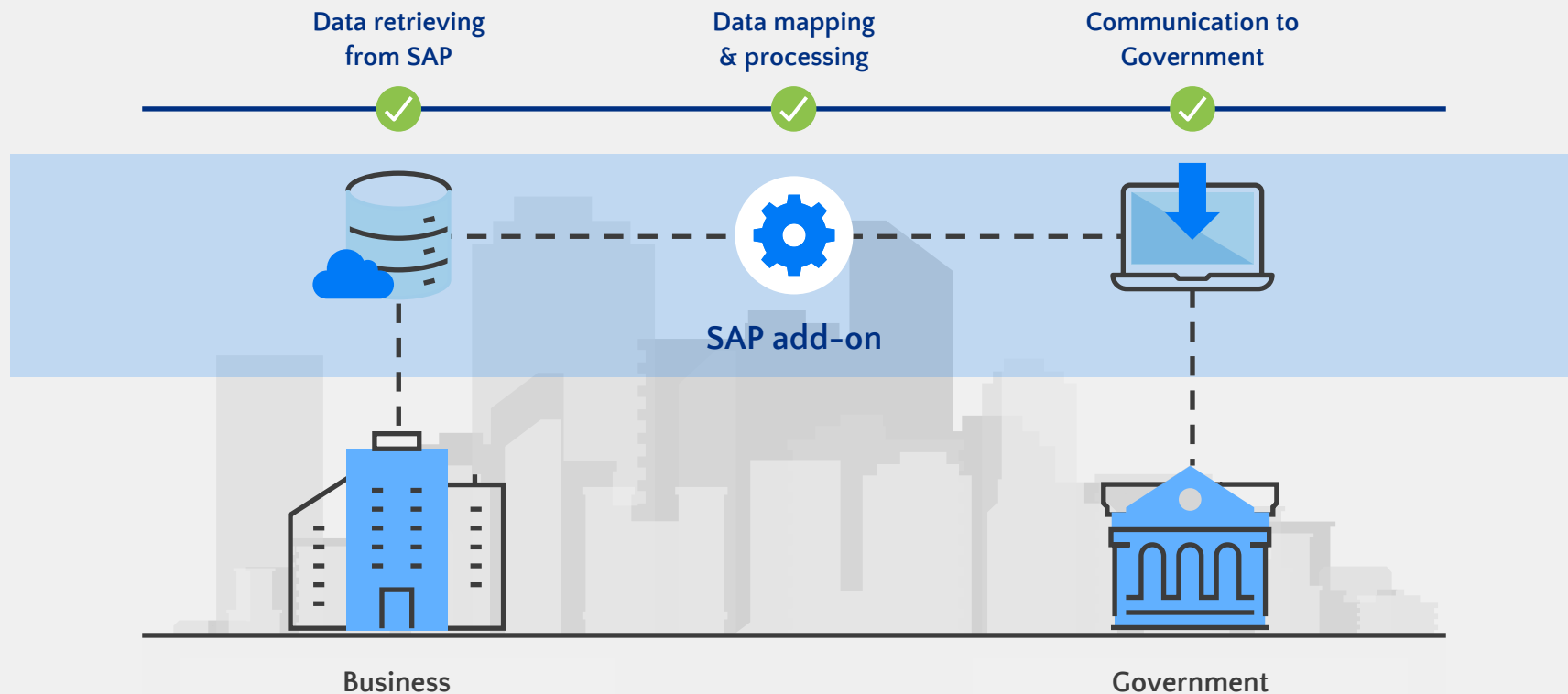
10 years archiving of e-invoices is mandatory. Can be archived by a third party without approval.

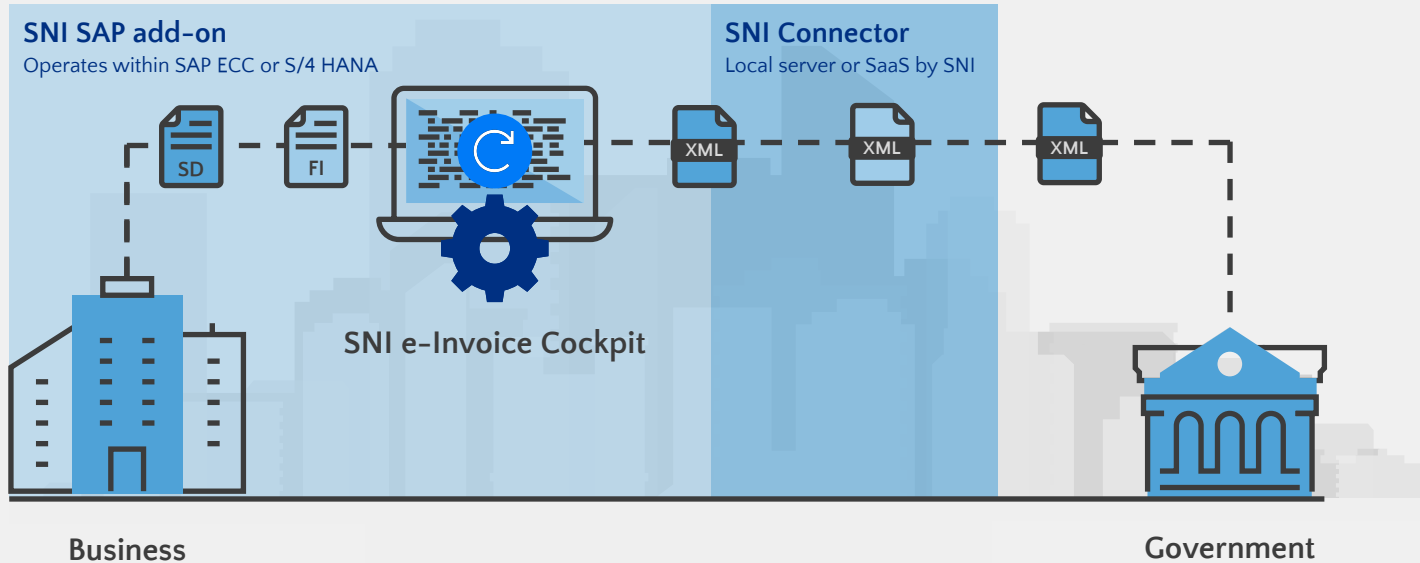

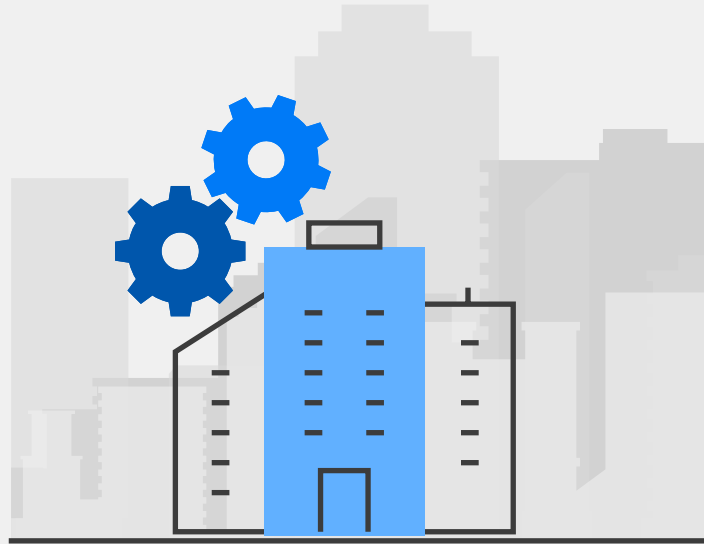

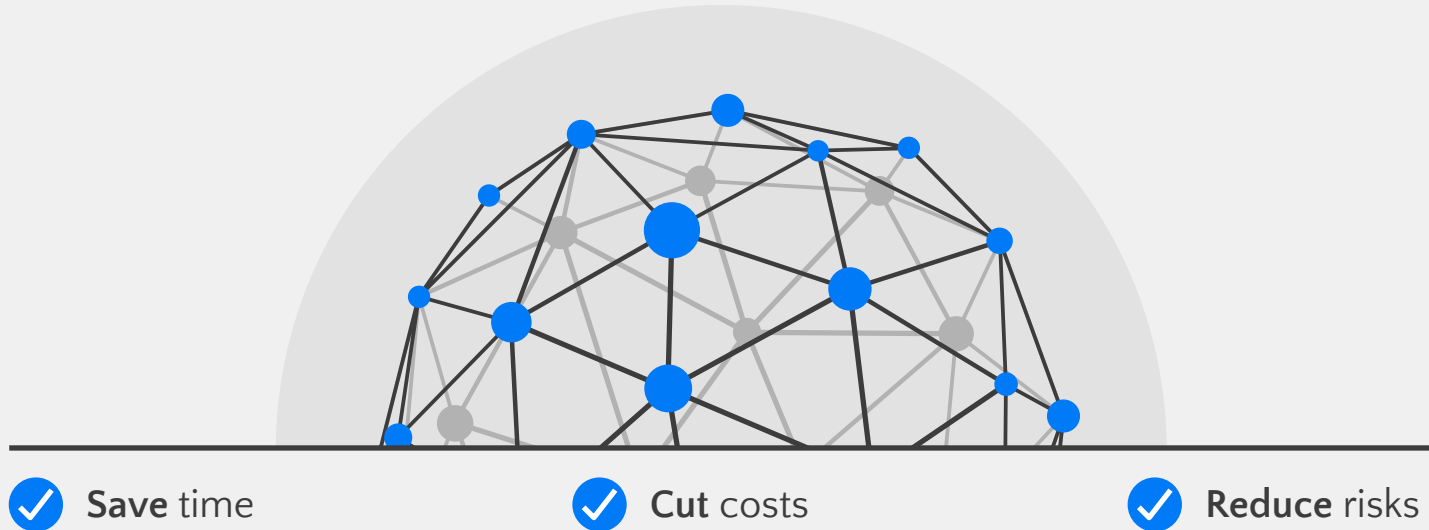
