Key points of the e-Invoice regulation in APAC Countries



General Information about e-Invoicing Models



Post Audit

- Supplier creates Tax Invoice and issue directly to the recipient
 - Control: Periodic tax filing
 - Invoice sample-audited later
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Invoice Reporting

- Required data file must be uploaded to the Tax Authority
 - Potentially on a daily basis
 - Supplier sends tax invoice to the recipient

Clearance

- Invoice information must be sent to the Tax Authority's platform simultaneously
- Structured info + code constitute the tax invoice
- Tax Authority validates tax and redirect the invoice

Australia e-Invoice System

- B2G and B2B Transactions
- Clearance Model
- B2G Transaction has been mandatory since July 2022
- For B2B transaction there is no official deadline.
- XML format
- Transmit e-Invoices via Peppol Network
- e-Invoices will be archived for a period of 5 years.
- There is no obligation to sign electronic invoices before submission to the Tax Authorities.
- In order to create invoices in line with the requirements of the PEPPOL Network, users must have an accredited PEPPOL Access Point.



New Zealand e-Invoice System

- B2G and B2B transactions
- For B2B transaction there is no official deadline.
- Clearance Model
- All taxpayers responsible who has New Zealand Business Number (NZBN)
- Tax Authority:
 - The Inland Revenue Department
 - The Ministry of Business, Innovation, and Employment (MBIE)
- B2G Transaction has been mandatory since March 2022
- Transmit e-Invoices via Peppol Network
- XML format



Thailand e-Invoice System

- B2B and B2C e-Tax Invoicing
- Voluntary basis since 2019
- Submitted to The Revenue Department
- Data integrity of e-Invoices are ensured by digital signature and e-Certificate
- e-Tax Invoice by email and e-Tax Invoice are two different systems and the main difference is the gross sales revenue threshold (30M Baht in a year)
- In order to submit invoices via H2H channel, the taxpayer must be eligible.
- If taxpayer is not eligible for H2H channel, The e-Invoices should be sent to the tax authority through a service provider.



Vietnam e-Invoice System

- B2G and B2B Transactions
- Submitted to General Department of Taxation
- Electronic invoice implementation completed in two phase;
 - Phase 1 started in November 2021 to March 2022
 - Phase 2 started in April 2022 to July 2022
- XML format
- Organizations, enterprises, households and individuals selling goods and/or providing services, buyers of goods/services, providers of electronic invoice-related services, and other electronic invoice-related services.
- The e-Invoices should be sent to the tax authority through the service provider.
- Once documents are sent to the service provider, they need to be signed digitally through a USB token on the service provider's portal to be sent to the recipient.



Philippines e-Invoice System

- B2B, B2C e-Invoicing / e-Receipt
- Pilot phase started in July 2022 for 100 large taxpayers
- Obligation deadline is not published yet
- JSON format
- Report to the government in 3 days
- Responsible taxpayers are;
 - engaged in the export of goods and/or services
 - engaged in electronic commerce
 - under the Large Taxpayers Service (LTS)
- Electronic document must be digitally signed before submit to the tax authority.
- Taxpayers should inform the tax authority when they issue and transmit the e-Documents.
- Regulation covers sales invoices, cash receipts, credit and debit notes and other fiscal documents.





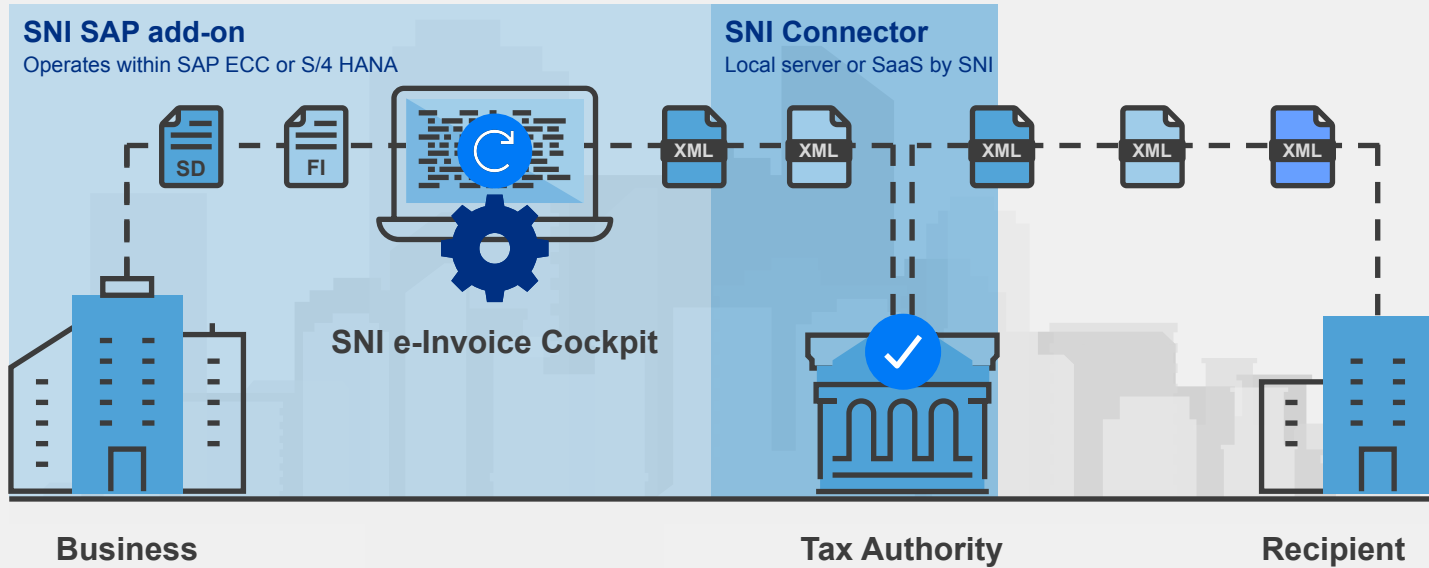

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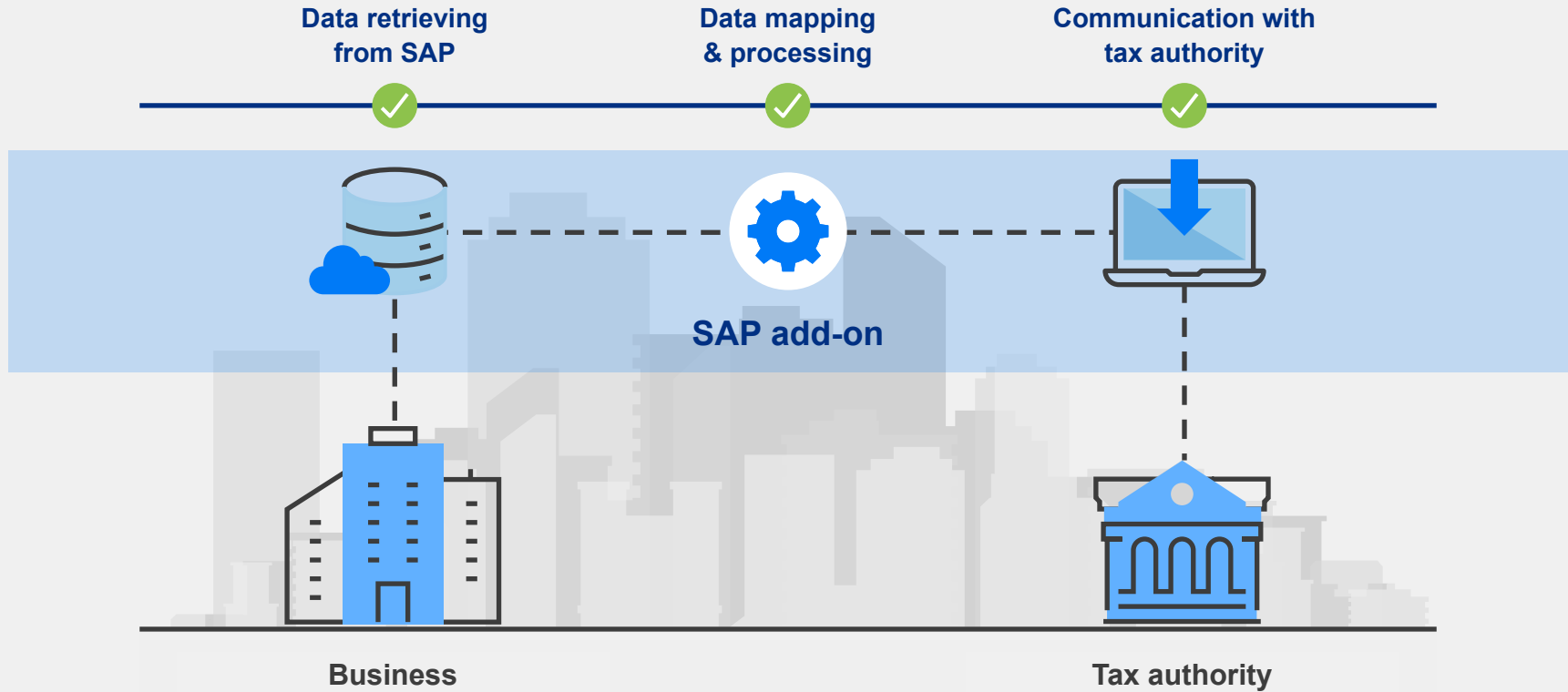

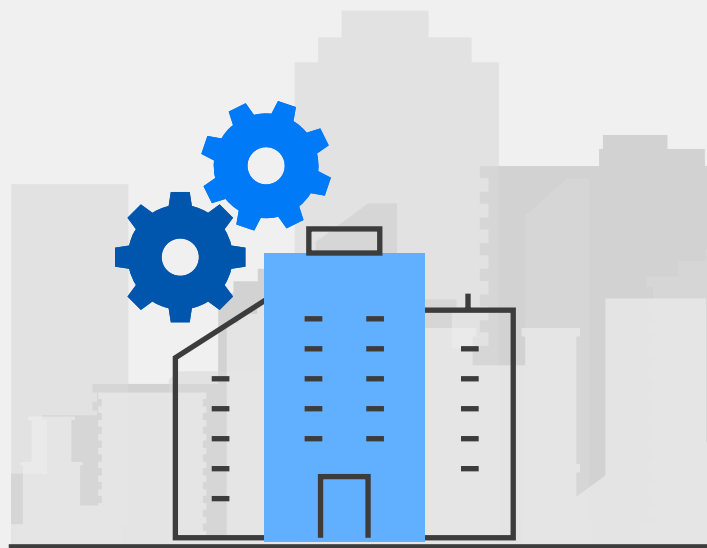
