# Kingdom of Saudi Arabia

# **SNi**

### Scope

Covers **B2B**, **B2C**, **exports**, and related **credit/debit notes**.

Applies to **all resident VAT-registered entities** in KSA.

Non-residents are excluded unless part of a VAT group with local presence.

### **Timeline & Phases**

Phase 1 – Generation (from Dec 4, 2021) All VAT-registered businesses must generate and store structured electronic invoices. Manual invoicing is no longer allowed.

Phase 2 – Integration (from Jan 1, 2023) Requires real-time clearance of B2B invoices and 24-hour reporting for B2C. Rolled out in waves based on turnover.

# Submission & Technical Requirements

Invoices must be in UBL 2.1 (XML) format or PDF/A-3 with embedded XML.

#### Must include:

Timestamp, Sequential ID, QR code (for B2C), Cryptographic e-signature/stamp

# Submitted via API to **ZATCA's FATOORAH portal**.

B2B: Real-time clearance beforeissuanceB2C: Reported within 24 hours afterissuance

Software must be **ZATCA-certified** and tamper-proof (with secure counters and logs).

### **Security & Validation**

Invoices must be **digitally signed** using cryptographic algorithms approved by ZATCA.

A **hash** of each invoice is stored to ensure traceability and prevent tampering.

Each invoice must have a **tamper-proof sequential counter**.

System must validate invoices before submission and prevent any manual edits post-generation.

ZATCA validates: Schema format, Digital signature, Mandatory fields, Invoice sequencing

# **United Arab Emirates**

### Scope & Legal Basis

Mandate covers all B2B and B2G transactions by VAT-registered entities. **Decree-Laws 16 & 17 of 2024** 

#### Timeline

Oct 2024: Official portal & roadmap launched by MoF. Apr 2025: ASP accreditation opens. Dec 2025: Pilot phase begins. Jul 2026: Mandatory go-live for all in-scope taxpayers.

#### **Invoice Types & Data Dictionary**

- Data Dictionary includes **135+ fields**, each marked mandatory/conditional.
- UAE defines 16 invoice scenarios, e.g.:

 $\rightarrow$  Standard, RCM, zero-rated, exports, e-commerce, free zone, margin scheme, credit notes, etc.

### e-Invoicing Model (5-Corner Architecture)



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- ASPs (Access Point Providers) mediate between sellers, buyers, and the FTA.
- Both seller's and buyer's ASPs transmit invoice data and report to the Ministry of Finance

Step	Description
1. Seller (Corner 1) $\rightarrow$ Seller's ASP (Corner 2)	Seller sends invoice in XML format with digital signature.
2. Seller's ASP (Corner 2) $\rightarrow$ Buyer's ASP (Corner 3)	Seller's ASP validates and forwards the invoice in PINT AE format.
3. Buyer's ASP (Corner 3) $\rightarrow$ Buyer (Corner 4)	Buyer's ASP delivers the invoice to the buyer.
4. Seller's ASP & Buyer's ASP (Corners 2 & 3) $\rightarrow$ MoF / FTA (Corner 5)	Both ASPs report tax data to MoF / FTA.
5. MoF / FTA (Corner 5) $\rightarrow$ Seller's ASP & Buyer's ASP (Corners 2 & 3)	MoF / FTA returns Message Level Status (MLS) confirming validation.
