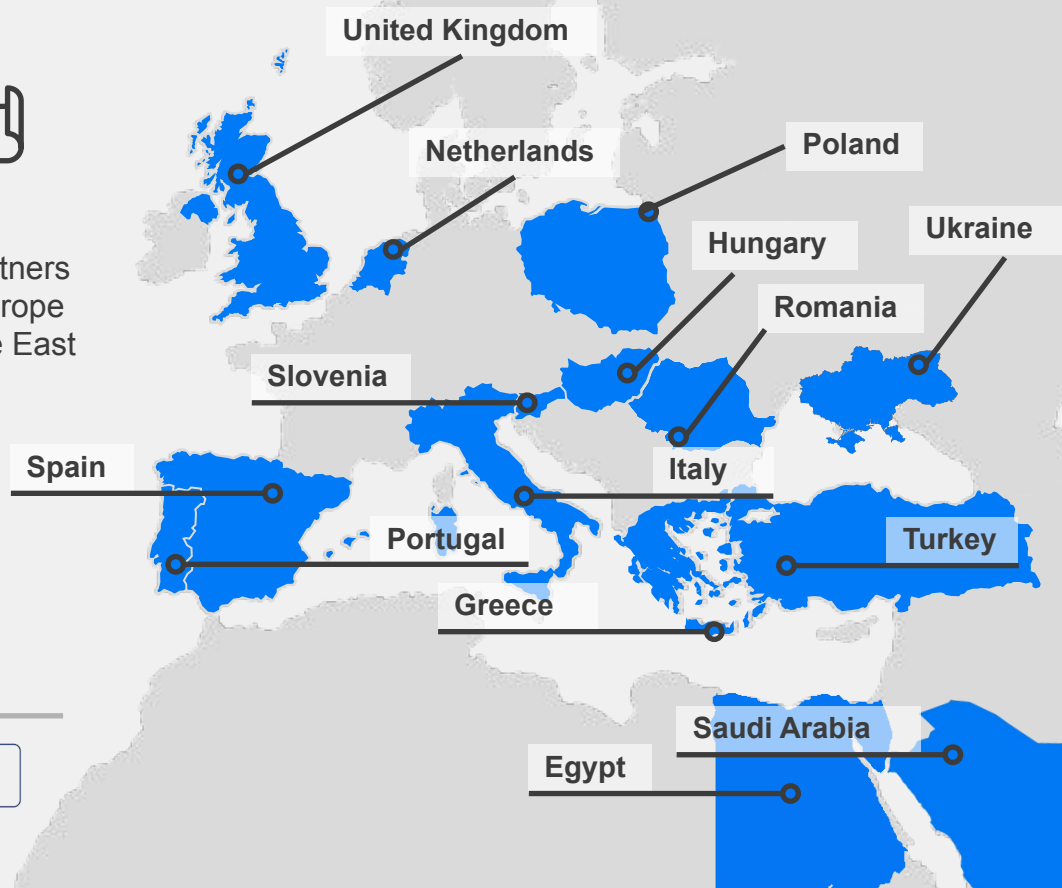

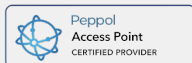

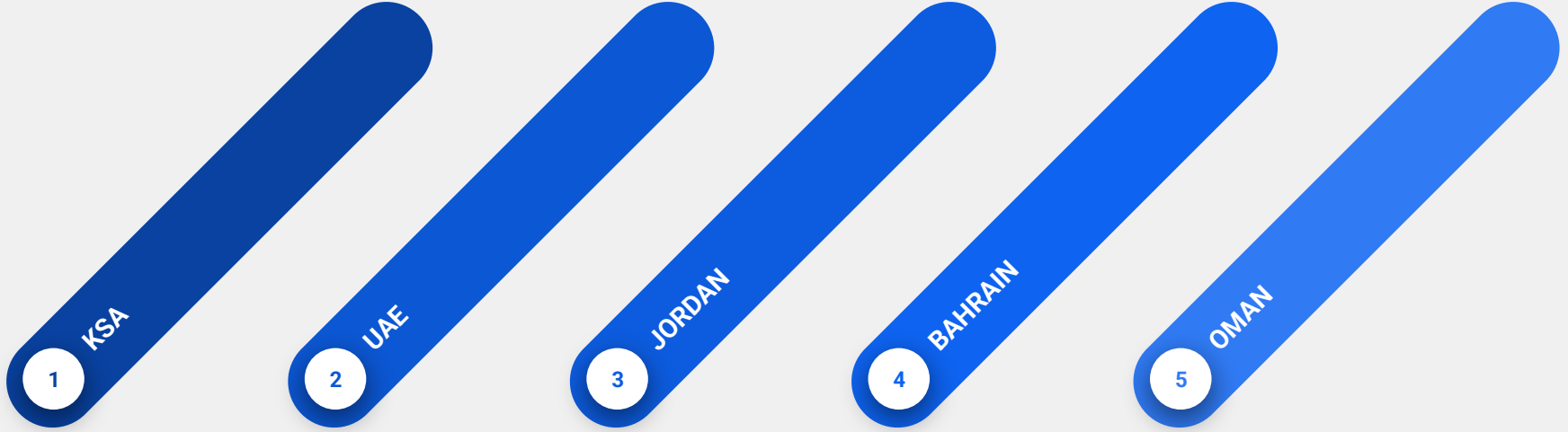

Kingdom of Saudi Arabia



Scope

Covers **B2B, B2C, exports**, and related **credit/debit notes**.

Applies to **all resident VAT-registered entities** in KSA.

Non-residents are excluded unless part of a VAT group with local presence.

Timeline & Phases

Phase 1 – Generation (from Dec 4, 2021)

All VAT-registered businesses must generate and store structured electronic invoices. Manual invoicing is no longer allowed.

Phase 2 – Integration (from Jan 1, 2023)

Requires real-time clearance of B2B invoices and 24-hour reporting for B2C. Rolled out in waves based on turnover.

Submission & Technical Requirements

Invoices must be in UBL 2.1 (XML) format or PDF/A-3 with embedded XML.

Must include:

Timestamp, Sequential ID, QR code (for B2C), Cryptographic e-signature/stamp

Submitted via API to **ZATCA's FATOORAH portal**.

B2B: Real-time clearance before issuance

B2C: Reported within 24 hours after issuance

Software must be **ZATCA-certified** and tamper-proof (with secure counters and logs).

Security & Validation

Invoices must be **digitally signed** using cryptographic algorithms approved by ZATCA.

A **hash** of each invoice is stored to ensure traceability and prevent tampering.

Each invoice must have a **tamper-proof sequential counter**.

System must **validate invoices before submission** and prevent any manual edits post-generation.

ZATCA validates: Schema format, Digital signature, Mandatory fields, Invoice sequencing

Scope & Legal Basis

Mandate covers all B2B and B2G transactions by VAT-registered entities.

Decree-Laws 16 & 17 of 2024

Timeline

Oct 2024: Official portal & roadmap launched by MoF.

Apr 2025: ASP accreditation opens.

Dec 2025: Pilot phase begins.

Jul 2026: Mandatory go-live for all in-scope taxpayers.

Invoice Types & Data Dictionary

- Data Dictionary includes **135+ fields**, each marked mandatory/conditional.
- UAE defines **16 invoice scenarios**, e.g.:
 - Standard, RCM, zero-rated, exports, e-commerce, free zone, margin scheme, credit notes, etc.

e-Invoicing Model (5-Corner Architecture)

- UAE uses a Peppol-based DCTCE model called PINT AE.
- ASPs (Access Point Providers) mediate between sellers, buyers, and the FTA.
- Both seller's and buyer's ASPs transmit invoice data and report to the Ministry of Finance

Step	Description
1. Seller (Corner 1) → Seller's ASP (Corner 2)	Seller sends invoice in XML format with digital signature.
2. Seller's ASP (Corner 2) → Buyer's ASP (Corner 3)	Seller's ASP validates and forwards the invoice in PINT AE format.
3. Buyer's ASP (Corner 3) → Buyer (Corner 4)	Buyer's ASP delivers the invoice to the buyer.
4. Seller's ASP & Buyer's ASP (Corners 2 & 3) → MoF / FTA (Corner 5)	Both ASPs report tax data to MoF / FTA.
5. MoF / FTA (Corner 5) → Seller's ASP & Buyer's ASP (Corners 2 & 3)	MoF / FTA returns Message Level Status (MLS) confirming validation.

Scope of Mandate

Applies to all VAT-registered businesses with annual turnover over JOD 75,000

Covers B2B, B2C, and B2G transactions

Non-compliance results in invalid VAT deduction and penalties (approx. JOD 500)

System Model & Platform

System Name: JoFotara

Centralized clearance platform

Platform Access: Via JoFotara Portal or direct API

Accredited Providers: Not mandatory but optional for ERP/API integration support

Invoice Format

Primary Format: XML structured according to the ISTD schema

JSON used in API responses or metadata

QR is generated by JoFotara platform after validation

Supported Document Types:

Tax invoice (standard), Simplified invoice (B2C), Credit Note / Debit Note, Self-billed invoice

Submission Methods

- 1. Real-Time API Integration**

Suitable for ERP-connected or high-volume taxpayers

Process: Send XML → Receive QR → Finalize Invoice
- 2. Manual Portal Upload**

For SMEs or low-volume issuers

Input data directly on JoFotara portal/upload XML

BAHRAIN



Authority

Managed by the **National Bureau for Revenue (NBR)**

Linked to Bahrain's VAT compliance strategy

Submission & Format

Submission via **ERP, API, or NBR portal**

Format likely based on **XML (UBL standard)**

No mandatory digital signatures yet

Invoices must be archived for **5 years**

E-Invoicing Model

Based on a **Post-Audit (Post-Clearance)** model

No real-time pre-clearance required

Future phases may adopt hybrid or real-time models

Scope

Currently **voluntary** for B2B and B2G

Applies to **VAT-registered businesses**

Full mandate expected in **late 2025 or 2026**

Public Consultation	2022–2024
System Development	In progress
Pilot Phase	Expected Sept 1, 2025
Mandatory Rollout	Expected 2025/2026

OMAN



Compliance Model

Uses a **decentralized 5-corner model** based on **PEPPOL**

Middleware and accredited providers act as intermediaries

Regulatory Authority & Legal Framework

Governed by **Oman Tax Authority (OTA)**

Based on **Ministerial Decision No. 456/2022**

E-invoicing defined under amended VAT regulations

Scope

Mandatory for all VAT-registered entities, regardless of size or sector

B2B – structured e-invoice mandatory

B2C – simplified e-invoice format may be used (e.g. retail, hospitality)

B2G / G2B – government-related transactions must be electronic

Technical Setup

Platform built by **Omantel + OTA**

Accredited service providers (ASPs) required

PEPPOL standards for invoice exchange

Registration and testing start in 2025

Phase	Date	Description
System Design & Planning	Sep 2025	OTA and Omantel begin designing the e-Invoice platform
Pilot Launch	Sep 1, 2026	Approx. 100 largest taxpayers join the pilot
Main Rollout (Phase I)	Jan 2027	Mandatory for large B2B taxpayers
Broader Rollout (Phase II)	Sept 2027	Extended to all VAT-registered businesses
G2B Integration	Jan 2028	Includes government-related invoicing (public sector coverage)
